Whether you want to go leaf peeping or golfing, we rounded up the best places for you to visit this month.

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You can't beat Boston in the fall. Of course, its biggest autumnal draw is the foliage turning brilliant shades of amber, red and orange throughout the city **BETA** But this year brings another reason to visit: the Boston Marathon, which usually occurs in April, will take place October 11. It's the first time that the marathon will happen in the fall and the first time it's been held since 2019.

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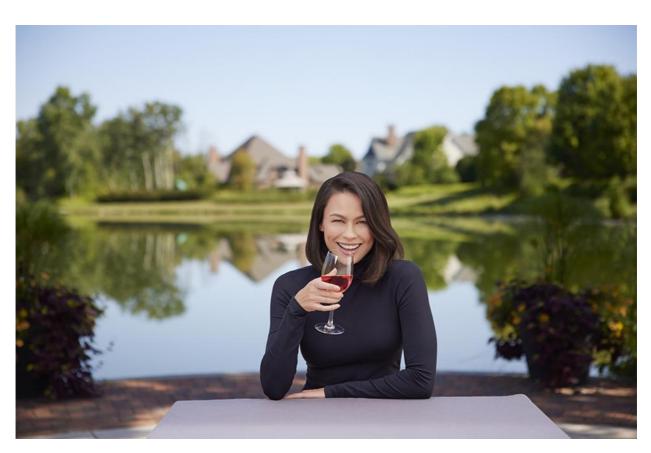

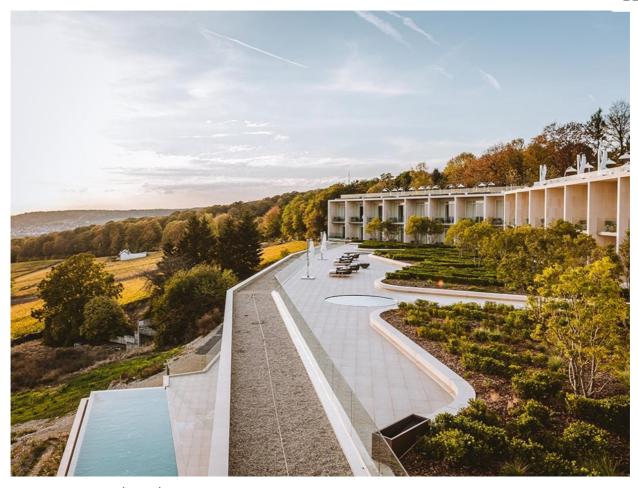
