We would like to highlight the following reservation conditions:


- During busy periods (April - October) some Champagne Houses require **several weeks of advance booking**. Therefore, we cannot guarantee their availability.







Electric bikes

To discover the Champagne vineyards at the pace of the surrounding landscapes, we invite you to enjoy our electric bike rental service.

Fatbike

📍 Festigny 🚗 30 min

Explore the vineyards on an electric fat bike, accompanied by a guide. Comfortable and suitable for all types of terrain, it offers a unique immersion in the heart of the vineyards. Two experiences are available:

Champagne landscapes, vineyards and panoramic views over the Marne Valley - 3h

Meet a local winemaker, followed by a champagne and chocolate tasting - 4h

The itinerary can be adjusted according to your preferences and any specific requests. Comfortable clothing suitable for cycling is recommended.

Guided bike tour

Immerse yourself in the heart of Champagne's iconic landscapes, along vineyard roads, charming villages and remarkable viewpoints. Accompanied by your guide Jean Charles, you will discover the secrets of the villages, the work of the vines and the richness of Champagne's wildlife and flora.

Ride including a visit or tasting - 3h/4 h

Mushroom foraging ride (September and October) - 2h

"Bio and Nature" discovery day (lunch included) - 8h

The experience includes the rental of an electric bike as well as equipment (helmet, saddle bag, water bottle) and your accompanying guide. A visit and tasting can be added, as well as a picnic according to your preferences.

Horse riding

📍 Bergères-les-Vertus 🚗 30 min

Let yourself be carried by the gentle pace of your horse as you explore the landscapes of the Côte des Blancs. Guided by Ingrid, you will ride through the Champagne vineyards in a calm and authentic atmosphere.

It is recommended to arrive 30 minutes before the meeting time to meet your horse, create a first connection and take part in its preparation.

Comfortable and appropriate clothing is recommended. Trousers and closed shoes are required. This activity is reserved for adults and is not suitable for children.

Donkey walk

This friendly and playful experience invites you to walk along paths winding through woods, vineyards and the region's typical landscapes, while creating a unique bond with the donkey accompanying you.

These walks are not donkey rides. A guide will accompany you throughout the experience. Comfortable clothing suitable for walking is recommended.

Marne River Escape

📍 Mareuil sur Aÿ 🚗 15 min

Let yourself drift along the water during an elegant and peaceful boat ride, accompanied by your captain Jérôme. Enjoy an unforgettable experience aboard the Maaskruiser, a Dutch boat from 1927, and discover Champagne from a different perspective along the Marne Valley.

Private "Bullet 1927" cruise - 1h30, 2h ou 3h30

Includes a bottle of champagne from a small local producer. A picnic or a stop at a champagne winemaker can also be arranged for a more authentic immersion in the Champagne terroir.

There is no specific dress code for the cruise. Please note that the air can be cooler near the water. Pets are not allowed on board. The cruise is subject to weather conditions and may be cancelled in case of bad weather.

Private cruise

📍 Mareuil sur Aÿ 🚗 15 min

As the water gently carries you along, admire the Champagne landscapes listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Green riverbanks, vineyards and unique viewpoints unfold before you aboard a silent and environmentally friendly solar powered boat.

Private cruise - 1h30 ou 3h

Private sunset cruise - 6h

Enjoy a relaxing moment at sunset in the Nordic bath with a glass of champagne.

Hot air balloon

Take to the skies aboard a hot air balloon and gently soar over the Montagne de Reims and its surrounding landscapes.

Flights are offered at sunrise (around 6am) and at sunset (around 5pm) for a truly extraordinary experience.

The activity lasts approximately 3 hours in total, including the preparation of the balloon and the flight. Reserved for guests over 7 years old and taller than 1m10.

Flights are strictly subject to weather conditions and may be cancelled at the last minute for safety reasons.

Honey farm experience

📍 Hautvillers 🚗 10 min


Discover the fascinating world of Champagne beekeeping. The visit begins with an introduction to beekeeping and the life of the bee, followed by a walk to the apiary to observe the bees at work in their natural environment. You will then witness the extraction of freshly harvested honey and conclude the experience with a tasting of regional honeys, revealing the unique flavors of the Champagne terroir.


The activity lasts 2h30 and is available from April to September, depending on weather conditions.

- Visit to the apiary (a car is required)
- Introduction to bees and beekeeping
- Honey extraction
- Jarring and tasting

Protective suits and boots will be provided by the beekeeper.




Lehmann experience

📍 Reims 🚗 30 min

Tasting champagne is an experience in itself, but understanding the importance of the glass in which it is served transforms the tasting entirely.

Immerse yourself in the world of the Reims based glassmaker Lehmann through a unique and immersive experience dedicated to the art of glass and its essential role in expressing Champagne. Through a sensory and educational approach, you will discover how the shape, finesse and design of the glass influence the aromas, texture and overall perception of the wine.



The experience takes place in an intimate setting and lasts approximately 1h30. Visual and sound sequences enhance the immersion and accompany the discovery.

This activity is reserved for adults and is not suitable for children.

The Champagne Cooperage opens its doors to reveal a rare and authentic craft at the heart of barrel making. The team welcomes you for an immersion into the world of wood and wine, an experience suited to professionals, wine enthusiasts and the simply curious alike.

Visit, two workshops on barrel assembly and hooping, followed by a tasting of three champagnes. Minimum of 6 people.




Reims, "City of Coronation"

 30 min

Nicknamed the "City of Coronations," Reims is a city rich in historical and cultural heritage. It is world renowned for its majestic cathedral, but also for its refined way of life combining gastronomy and remarkable architecture.

- **Notre Dame Cathedral of Reims** : A masterpiece of Gothic architecture, it hosted nearly all the coronations of the kings of France. Its sculpted façade and remarkable stained glass windows make it an essential visit. Just a few steps away lies Place Royale, dating from the eighteenth century, with a statue of Louis XV standing at its center.
- **Forum Square District** : One of the liveliest squares in the historic center, where the remains of an ancient open air Roman theatre can still be seen. Nearby, Rue du Tambour stands out for its mural frescoes that bring a contemporary artistic touch to the area.
- **Porte de Mars and the Boulingrin Market Hall** : The Porte de Mars, a Roman triumphal arch from the third century, is considered the widest surviving Roman arch in the world. Les Halles du Boulingrin, a famous Art Deco covered market, host a lively market every Saturday morning where local producers and artisans gather.
- **City Center** : The main shopping street, Rue de Vesle, together with its surrounding streets, offers numerous boutiques. It is located close to Place d'Erlon, where many restaurants and cafés can be found.




Épernay, "Capital of Champagne"

 15 min

Épernay, often referred to as the "Capital of Champagne," is the perfect place to discover the history, craftsmanship and culture of the region. The town stands out for its prestigious wine heritage and its location at the heart of the Champagne vineyards.

Here are a few suggestions for an ideal day in Épernay:

- **Stroll along the Avenue de Champagne** : Formerly known as Avenue du Commerce, this elegant avenue stretches for nearly one kilometre through Épernay. Over the centuries, the great Champagne Houses have built magnificent residences along its length, serving as the headquarters of their brands or as private homes for their owners.
- **Visit the Champagne Wine and Regional Archaeology Museum** : Located in the recently renovated Château Perrier, this museum invites you to explore the fascinating history of Champagne production as well as the archaeological heritage of the region. A unique place to understand the evolution of this long standing tradition.
- **Discover Épernay's historic center** : Take a walk through the small streets of the town center, where charming boutiques and historic buildings contribute to the character and beauty of the city.



Hautvillers, the Birthplace of Champagne

 10 min

Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Hautvillers is an emblematic village of the Champagne wine region. It was here that the Benedictine monk Dom Pérignon laid the foundations of the Champagne method. The village charms visitors with its historic heritage, picturesque streets and the wrought iron signs decorating each corner, a testament to its rich past.

We highly recommend visiting:

- **Abbey Church of Saint Sindulphe** : The church houses the tombs of Dom Ruinart and Dom Pierre Pérignon, making it a place of pilgrimage for wine enthusiasts from around the world.
- **“Les Tuileaux” Viewpoint** : With its picnic tables, it is the perfect spot to admire beautiful sunsets overlooking the vineyards.
- **Small Champagne producers** : Around twenty producers in the village welcome visitors for Champagne tastings.



🍷 Montagne de Reims 📍 Avenay Val d'Or 🚗 15 min

Champagne Augustin welcomes guests in a family home deeply committed to biodynamic practices. The visit focuses on this vibrant approach to the vine and to wine, far from traditional formats, offering a genuine immersion into their philosophy.

An inspiring discovery for those curious to understand Champagne differently, in close connection with the rhythm of nature.

A rare particularity in Champagne, the estate is also a vine nursery, with genuine expertise in the selection and production of vine plants.

Champagne Nicolas Maillart


🍷 Montagne de Reims 📍 Ecueil 🚗 15 min

The Nicolas Maillart estate stands out for its contemporary architectural style, its cellars lined with barrels, and the refined atmosphere of the visit.

The tasting is both elegant and precise and is accompanied by a surprising collection of vintage cars, a distinctive signature of the house. A special mention goes to the Montchenot cuvée, ideal for a picnic or to enjoy with a selection of cheeses.

Clos Corbier

 Vallée de la Marne  Mareuil sur Aÿ  15 min

Discover Clos Corbier, a nineteenth century residence full of character nestled in the heart of the vineyards. The visit takes you through its small vineyard planted with the three Champagne grape varieties, its traditional press and its cellars. The experience continues with a tasting workshop to explore and understand the aromas, followed by a convivial regional lunch celebrating the Champagne art of living.

Clos des Bergeronneau

 Montagne de Reims  Ville-Dommange  20 min

Le Clos des Bergeronneau offers a gentle visit that combines the discovery of the clos and its presses, the tasting of base wines, and guided tastings.

The experience can be accompanied by platters of cheeses and charcuterie, all set in the heart of a charming flower filled village.

Château de Boursault

 Vallée de la Marne  Boursault  20 min

Château de Boursault is set in a historic nineteenth century setting in the heart of the vineyards. The visit allows guests to discover the estate, its press and its cellars in a peaceful and authentic atmosphere.

A place rich in history, the château overlooks the surrounding vineyards and offers a spectacular panorama over the region. Built in the nineteenth century by Madame Clicquot, it reflects the prestigious history of Champagne.

Champagne Pierre Paillard

 Montagne de Reims  Bouzy  25 min

The Paillard brothers welcome you to their estate in Bouzy for an immersive and original experience. The journey begins in the heart of the vineyard with a ride in an electric Méhari, then continues in the historic chalk cellars carved by hand.

To complete the visit, it is possible to enjoy a moment at the chef's table, paired with the estate's champagnes.

Champagne André Clouet

 Montagne de Reims  Bouzy  25 min

Champagne André Clouet welcomes guests into a family home located in the heart of a historic clos. An authentic discovery rooted in the history and identity of Champagne.

The visit highlights a traditional winery and beautiful vaulted cellars dating from 1741, true witnesses to a know how that has been passed down and preserved for several generations.

Champagne Maison Penet

 Montagne de Reims  Verzy  25 min

Champagne Penet welcomes you in Verzy, in the heart of a Grand Cru village. The visit offers the opportunity to discover an independent family house, renowned for its champagnes made predominantly from Pinot Noir. The tasting may also include base wines, depending on availability.

The House also offers gastronomic experiences, where its champagnes are paired with refined cuisine.

Champagne Moussé

 Vallée de la Marne  Cuisles  25 min
